## Goals/Objectives

- Identify appropriate uses of femtosecond laser assisted corneal tattooing. Explain the advantages of femto-assisted corneal tattooing as a treatment method.
- Distinguish between types of lamellar keratoplasty. Describe the differences, results, recovery time and complications for DALK, PK, EK, DMEK and DSAEK.
- Compare MSICS to other treatment procedures, including patient outcomes, complications and monetary differences. Identify any advantages to utilizing MSICS, particularly in the developing world.
