#### Goals/Objectives

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- *Evaluate fundus images according to current practice standards, apply evidence-based studies to determine appropriate therapies to treat AMD, and effectively discuss future AMD therapies with patients.*
- *Interpret color fundus images, interpret OCT findings, and summarize current understandings of peripheral retinal disease risks and cataract surgery.*
- *Effectively evaluate patients with symptoms of acute retinal artery occlusions, evaluate patients for Giant Cell Arteritis when appropriate, and identify nearby stroke centers or emergency departments for urgent care.*
- *Plan for management of care to reduce the burden of myopia, explain the known therapeutic options for reducing myopia and recognize the economic impact myopia may have in the future.*
- *Differentiate between phacoemulsification and small incision techniques, analyze all treatment options and identify the treatment option which will provide for the best visual rehabilitation.*
- *Examine and analyze new and emerging device options for cataract treatment and surgery and summarize the differences, similarities, effectiveness and potential complications.*
- *Describe MIGS, summarize the development and utilization of MIGs and identify MIGS treatment options.*
- *Describe early detection and intervention procedures for pediatric cataracts, analyze the treatment options, and describe procedures to mitigate postoperative glaucoma.*
